

"Should Say" Comics

How to Give Advice

We use the verb **should** to give advice or make suggestions. It tells someone what is the right or good thing to do.

Pattern: Person + should + verb (base form)

- **Positive:** You **should** wear a helmet.
- **Negative:** You **should not (shouldn't)** run near the pool.



Tip: When writing comics, keep your advice short and clear so it fits in the speech bubble!

Comic Strip Challenge

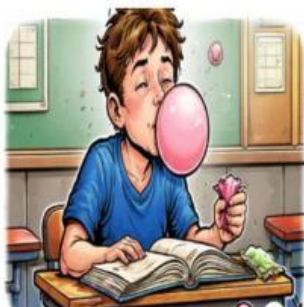
Look at the situations below. Something is wrong in each scene! Act as the friend or helper and write the best advice in the "Speech Bubble" box using **should** or **shouldn't**.
