Deforestation, pollution, and climate change are just a few of the challenges facing the planet's varied ecosystems, from tropical rainforests to coral reefs.

Ecosystems are complex networks of plants, animals, and microorganisms interacting with their physical environment. These interactions are critical for sustaining life, providing services such as air and water purification, pollination of crops, and climate regulation.
