The Present Perfect

This cool tense helps us talk about our life story and what we've experienced!

It's about
your
EXPERIENCE.

Think about all the fun
things you've done,
seen, or tried!



Not when it happened!

We don't care about the exact time, just that it
happened!



The Structure of Present Perfect

The Formula: Subject + Have / Has + Past Participle

- Use "Have" for I, You, We, They.
- Use "Has" for He, She, It.

Examples:

- I **have eaten** pizza. (Yummy!)
- She **has traveled** to Quito. (Adventure!)
- We **have learned** English. (Awesome!)

☐ When you didn't do something, just make **have/has** negative!
Like, "I haven't seen that movie."

Present Perfect

Subject + Have/Has + Past Participle

Use "Have" for I, We, They

Use "Has" for He, She, It



I have eaten pizza



She has traveled to Quito

Use Has: He, She, It



We have learned English

The Golden Rule!

Life Experience

Present Perfect

"I have eaten pizza."

"I have been to Quito."

Focus: THE EXPERIENCE (Life).

@ Specific Time

Past Simple

"I ate pizza *yesterday*."

"I went to Quito *last year*."

Focus: WHEN it happened.
