

ENGLISH PRACTICE: PRESENT SIMPLE & DAILY ROUTINES

GRAMMAR SUMMARY: THE RULES

- **Affirmative:** * Use the base verb for **I, You, We, They** (e.g., *I wake up*).
 - Add **-s, -es, or -ies** for **He, She, It** (e.g., *She wakes up, He studies*).
 - **Negative:** * Use **don't** + verb for **I, You, We, They**.
 - Use **doesn't** + verb (base form) for **He, She, It**.
 - **Interrogative (Questions):** * Use **Do** + subject + verb...? (e.g., *Do you play?*).
 - Use **Does** + subject + verb...? (e.g., *Does he cook?*).
 - **Adverbs of Frequency:** * Place them **before** the main verb (e.g., *I **always** wash the dishes*).
 - Place them **after** the verb *To Be* (e.g., *He is **often** late*).
