A. Full infinitive, bare infinitive or perfect infinitive.

B. Gerund or Infinitive?

5. **It's no use** (tell) her to watch this movie. She doesn't like it.

7. I **look forward to** (travel) to New York.
8. I **heard** the dog (bark) last night.
9. They **remember** (play) with the snow when they were young.
