In	Dentro de	<i>The cat is in the box.</i>
On	Sobre / Encima de (tocando superficie)	<i>The book is on the table.</i>
Under	Debajo de	<i>The shoes are under the bed.</i>
Below	Por debajo de (sin tocar, a un nivel inferior)	<i>The painting is below the clock.</i>
Above	Por encima de (sin tocar, a un nivel superior)	<i>The lamp is above the sofa.</i>
Next to	Al lado de	<i>The chair is next to the desk.</i>
Behind	Detrás de	<i>The boy is behind the door.</i>
In front of	En frente de	<i>The car is in front of the house.</i>
Between	En medio de (dos cosas)	<i>The pen is between the books.</i>

¿Cuál es la diferencia entre "Under" y "Below"?

Under: Se usa mucho cuando algo está directamente debajo o incluso cubierto (ej: under the blankets).

Below: Se usa más para niveles. Si estás en una escalera, el escalón que sigue hacia abajo está below you.

- **In:** "Dentro de algo".
- **On:** "Sobre una superficie".
- **At:** "En un lugar específico" (sin importar si estás exactamente dentro o fuera, sino el concepto del lugar).
