Wheelchair basketball



Wheelchair basketball is played on the **same court** as normal basketball. There are **five players** on each team, and the **net is the same height**. Some rules are different. Players can **hold the ball and push their wheelchair two times** before throwing the ball. In normal basketball, players **cannot do this**.

Wheelchair rugby

Wheelchair rugby uses a **round ball**, not a rugby-shaped ball. This makes it **easier to catch and throw**. Each team has **four players**. A team scores when a player **carries the ball into the goal area**. The game is **very fast**, but it can be **dangerous**. Players often **crash into each other**, so they use **strong wheelchairs** to stay safe.



Sitting volleyball



Sitting volleyball has **six players** on each team. The court is **smaller**, and the **net is lower** than normal volleyball. Players **sit all the time** and use their **arms to move**. The game is **fast and exciting**. People **with or without disabilities** can play together using the **same rules**.
