Football, or soccer in the U.S., dates back to 2500 B.C with the Chinese game of tsu chu. The sport we know today **originated** from Britain. Today, more than 120 million players over the globe participate in the game, making soccer the world's sport.

So, why is soccer so popular? Maybe it's a feeling that the team on the field is your team; their win is your victory, and their loss is your defeat. Or maybe it is the game's international quality. In countries like France, England, Spain, Brazil, major teams have players from many different nations, and these clubs now have fans all over the world. Or perhaps it's the promise of great wealth.
