

| Verbs: achieve / perform / forbidden / remained | Achieve = lograr; Perform = ejecutar; Forbidden = prohibido; Remained = permaneció | <i>The team achieved first place. / The athletes performed well. / Swimming without permission is forbidden. / He remained calm.</i> |
| Forbidden / Denied / Rejected / Refused | Forbidden = prohibido por reglas; Denied = negado oficialmente; Rejected = no aceptado; Refused = se niega voluntariamente | <i>Access to the field was forbidden. / The request was denied. / The proposal was rejected. / He refused to play.</i> |
| Make / Making / Made / Makes | Make = hacer (infinitivo); Making = haciendo; Made = hizo/hecho; Makes = hace (3ra persona) | <i>She made a goal. / He is making a plan.</i> |
| Will have / Do / Has | Will have = futuro perfecto; Do = acción o auxiliar presente; Has = presente 3ra persona singular | <i>By next year, the school will have a new stadium. / She has a uniform.</i> |
| None / Any / Anyone / Neither | None = ninguno; Any = alguno/algunos; Anyone = cualquiera; Neither = ninguno de los dos | <i>None of the players were injured. / Did anyone win? / Neither team scored.</i> |
