Free Flying

Many people understand how important *free flying* is for pet birds. This is when they fly outside and return to their owner. It can be challenging to train birds to do this. In the UK, between 50 and 100 pet owners free fly their birds, giving them a more natural life.

At first, Chloe trained him inside, only taking him outside when she was confident he understood he needed to return. She never used food to get him to come back. Motley loves Chloe so he always returns to her. Motley also loves this activity and now he knocks on the window when he wants to go out. Chloe takes him to the countryside, to places which he will find interesting.

There is always a danger that parrots will fly off. Molly and her parrot, Jekyll, recently got lost on a mountain in Wales. Usually, Jekyll is happy to fly free. He often does this in their garden, but this time some bigger birds attacked him and he flew away. Molly climbed the mountain to get Jekyll. The weather was good, but they got lost and couldn't get home. Molly quickly phoned for help. The parrot said 'hello' when the team arrived to save them!
