1. Hidden in almost every European country there are ancient and untouched forests. These forests are often rich in wildlife and are home to many endangered species. Although many of the ancient peoples of Europe worshipped trees, there is little respect for them today. The World Wildlife Fund has decided to draw attention to the importance of Europe's ancient woodlands. They are asking for the remaining forests to be preserved by

controlling the trade in wood. In addition, governments are being asked to restore forests and manage them in a more nature-friendly way.

At present, almost a third of western Europe is covered by trees. Unfortunately, many of these were only planted recently. This means they cannot support such a wide variety of plant and animal life. If we destroy the ancient forests, we will cause many species to become extinct. The decline of ancient forests began thousands of years ago. However, with the growing awareness of the value of ancient woodlands, it is hoped those remaining will be saved. It is not too late to do something for our ancient trees.

VIETNAMESE LIFESTYLE

In the past, many Vietnamese families had three or four generations living together under one roof. People believed that having many children would bring more happiness and good luck, so they wanted big families.

Because of old traditions, men had the most power in the family and made all the important decisions, while women had to follow strict rules. They had to obey their fathers when they were young, listen to their husbands after marriage, and rely on their sons when their husband passed away. Women were also expected to be hardworking, behave well, speak politely, and have good morals.

Over the past decades, the government has introduced new laws to make family life fairer. People started to understand more about gender equality, and women's rights improved. The government also worked to change old ways of thinking so that men and women could have equal roles in the family.

Today, Vietnamese families are smaller, with only two or three generations living together. Most couples have just two children, and the belief that men are more important than women is slowly disappearing. However, people still respect their elders and love their children, and these traditions remain an important part of Vietnamese family life.
