Rules for He, she, it	Examples
1. Add -s for most verbs	Work: works Read: reads Attend: attends
2. Add -es for words ending in -ch, -s, -sh, -x, or -z	Watch: watches Wash: washes Fix: fixes
3. If the verb ends in a consonant + y, change -y to -i and add -es	Study: studies Cry : cries
4. If the verb ends in a vowel + y, don't change the -y	Play: plays Pay: pays
5. Irregular forms	do: does go: goes have: has
