This is why even the top or smartest adult students have difficulty with pronunciation. There are several things that an international student can do to improve his or her pronunciation.

Studying pronunciation can help students to understand the rules of English, but in order to practice speaking, students often need **to be exposed to English** outside the classroom as well. This is why many students say that studying in an English-speaking country greatly affects their English.
