Demonstratives

Near: This (singular), These (plural)

Far: That (singular), Those (plural)

Examples:

I like **this store**.

I don't like **that store**.

These stores are cheap.

Those stores are expensive.

Talking About Prices

It is cheap.

It is expensive.

The prices are good.

The prices are high.

It is 20 dollars

Comparatives

Short adjectives: add -er (cheap → cheaper, big → bigger, small → smaller)

Long adjectives: use more (expensive → more expensive, organized → more organized)

Examples:

This store is bigger than that store.

That store is more expensive.
