On the fourth of December eighteen seventy-two, a ship called the *Mary Celeste* was found ¹ _____ in the Atlantic. There was no one on board. The ship wasn't ² _____, and everything was in order, although the lifeboat was missing. None of the crew or ³ _____ were ever seen again.

On the fourth of ⁴ _____ nineteen eighteen, a huge ship called the *USS Cyclops* left Barbados with three hundred people on ⁵ _____, and sailed into what we now call the Bermudas Triangle. Then it disappeared without a ⁶ _____. No distress call was made, and no bad weather was reported in the region. A huge search for the *Cyclops* was launched – boats and planes searched the area for wreckage or ⁷ _____ – but nothing of the enormous ship was ever seen again.

On July second, nineteen thirty-seven, Amelia Earhart, the famous ⁸ _____ aviator, took off with her navigator from New Guinea, in a small plane, on the last stage of their around-the-world ⁹ _____. It was the last time they were seen alive. Four million dollars was spent on the search, but ¹⁰ _____ trace of Amelia or the navigator was ever found.
