But the pot doesn't stop. It makes more and more and more porridge.

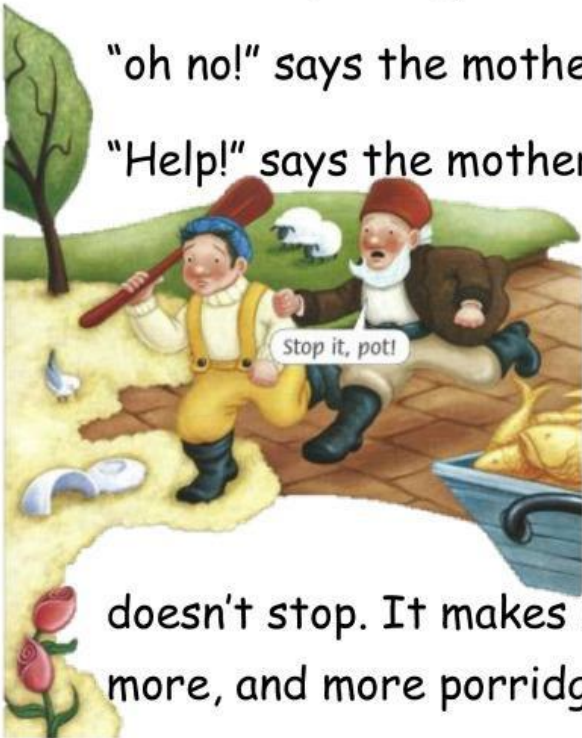
"oh no!" says the mother. "Help!"
