

ADVERB SUBORDINATE CLAUSES (ADVSC)

- **Function:** Modify verbs, adjectives, or adverbs.
- **Provide this information:** The ADVSC tells how? when? where? why? to what extent? or under what condition? about the word being modified.
- **Form:** Begin with subordinating conjunctions, like: because, as soon as, until, before, when, although, while, after, etc.
- **Location in a sentence:** Anywhere, usually before or after the independent clause.

PUNCTUATION RULES:

1. If the ADVSC begins the sentence (or, in other words, is located before the independent clause), always place a comma after it.
2. If the ADVSC is located after the independent clause, a comma is usually not needed.

Because I did not study for the test sufficiently, I barely passed.

Whenever Miranda looks at me, I just want to hide my face until she goes away.

My sister will need to do the dishes as soon as she can so that she will be ready when her friends get here.

Although we have already purchased our tickets to the concert, I want to arrive before the doors open because all seats are general admission.
