There will also be a special website for parents with detailed data about their son or daughter. Finally, there won't be any school trips or PE lessons. Instead of going on a trip by bus, students will put on special 3D glasses and will go on virtual trips to many amazing places. Sports and PE lessons will be virtual too. Students will play special 3D games, and thanks to them they will keep fit and healthy.
