Topic 9: Caring for my body

Your body is precious, so you must take care of it. Clean your teeth. Germs (bacteria) grow on dirty teeth. They can cause tooth decay (cavities) and toothache. You must use toothbrush and toothpaste to brush your teeth.

Brush every tooth and your tongue.

Brush your teeth in the morning and before going to sleep.

Take care! Too many sweets and fizzy drinks make your teeth bad.

Wash your hands

Germs make you sick. Dirty hands spread germs. Sneezing spreads germs too. Cover your nose when you sneeze. Then wash your hands.

You must wash your hands.

- Before touching and eating food.
- After touching dirt and animals.
- After playing
- After using the toilet.

We make things from materials. Materials have different properties.

- Paper is weak
- Metal is strong
- Stone is hard.
- Wet Clay is soft.
- Glass is smooth
- Brick is rough
- Plastic is lightweight.
- Stone can be heavy.

People use materials to make things.

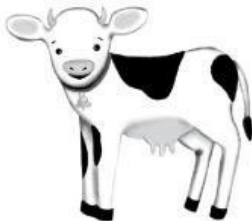
- Carpenter - A carpenter is a person who builds and fixes things made of wood.

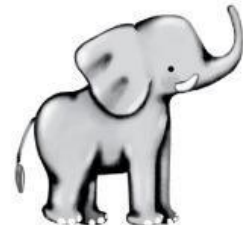
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Wild animal

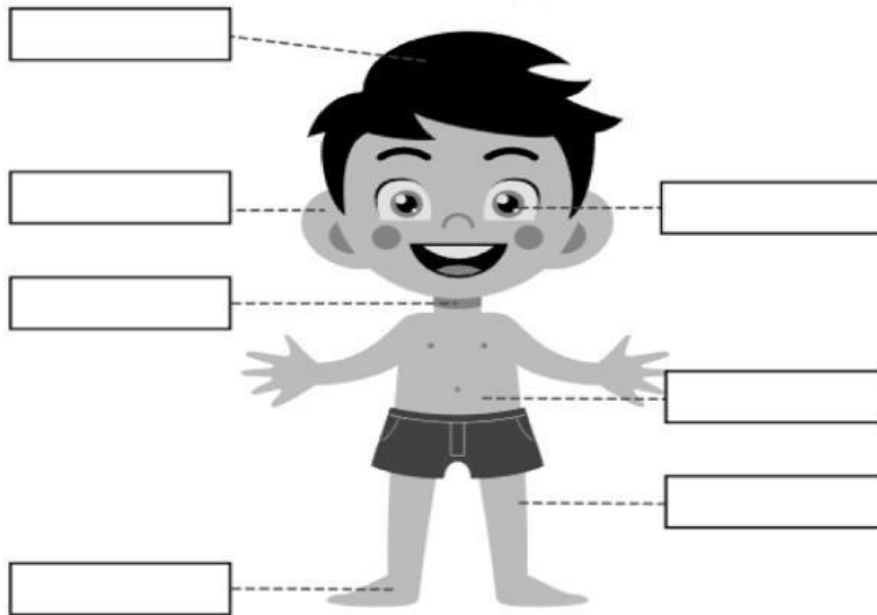
