1. Sakurajima volcano on Kyushu, in southwest Japan, erupted several times on November 16, 2025. **It** sent ash and smoke up to 4,400 metres into the sky. "This is the first time in nearly 13 months that an eruption reached 4 km or more", Kyodo News reported. Local media said this caused around 30 flight cancellations. Fortunately, there were no reports of injuries or death. The danger level stayed at three on a scale of five, so entry is strictly **banned** within a 2-kilometre radius of the mountain.

2. The Japanese Meteorological Agency reported that the first eruption happened at 12:57 a.m. at the Minamidake crater. Then, more eruptions followed at 2:30 a.m. and 8:50 a.m, and there were no reports of major eruptions around noon. Sakurajima is near Kagoshima city and is one of Japan's most active volcanoes. In 2019, ash were sent as high as 5,500 metres into the air. It erupts a little almost every day, but it usually doesn't affect travelling or tourism. Nearby residents are used to the hundreds of eruptions that happen daily.
