The black lace cactus is tiny, only 6 inches tall, and grows alone or in small groups in desert areas in Texas, the US. The plant is endangered because people have destroyed its habitat. In areas where farmers have converted the land to plant grass for cattle, the cactus has disappeared. The plant is very popular with collectors around the world because its large pink and purple flowers are very pretty. That's why the black lace cactus is often found in homes for private collections.

Once, the Apollo Butterfly was found all over European and Asian meadows. Nowadays it is very rare. In our country they have also put the butterfly on the list of endangered species in 1993. The species is found in many other countries, too: Sweden, Finland, Poland, the Czech Republic and it is illegal to catch, kill or harm it. The butterfly is endangered because human activities have destroyed its natural habitat. Air pollution and acid rain have also destroyed their habitat. Collectors are willing to pay for the beautiful butterfly and are ready to buy it at \$3,000.
