

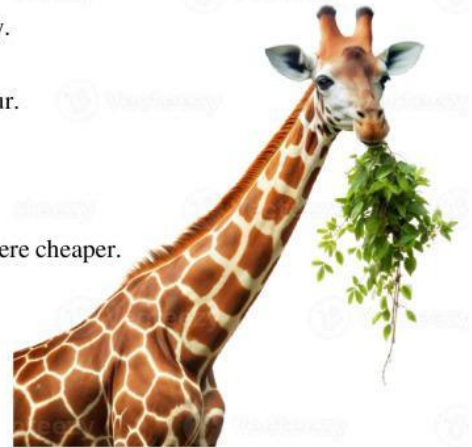

Wild animals live in many different places on Earth. Some animals live in hot jungles, some in cold mountains, and others in dry deserts. Every animal is special, and many animals are different in size, speed, and strength.

The **cheetah** is one of the fastest animals on land. It is faster than the lion and the tiger. However, the lion is stronger than the cheetah. Lions usually live in groups called prides, but cheetahs often hunt alone.
