This is another listening comprehension video. In it, you will review several important skills: understanding non-rhotic words, listening to directions, understanding numbers, etc. Before you watch the video and answer the questions, look at the vocabulary list below.

Vocabulary

- **hi-fi:** equipment for playing recorded music in high-fidelity sound (*equipo estéreo*)
- **chest of drawers:** a piece of furniture with drawers in which you keep things such as clothes (*una cómoda*)
- **practical:** skilled at manual tasks (*hábiloso*)
- **appointment:** an arrangement to meet someone at a particular time and place (*cita / turno / reunión*)
- **DIY:** an acronym (*acrónimo*) for “Do It Yourself” (*hazlo tú mismo*)
- **“hang on”:** an expression that means “wait a moment” (*espera un momento*)
- **roundabout:** a road junction at which traffic moves in one direction round a central island to reach one of the roads converging on it (*rotunda*)
- **lovely:** beautiful or attractive (*hermoso*)
- **gorgeous:** beautiful or attractive (*hermoso / espléndido*)
- **How about...?:** an expression used to make a suggestion or to ask for an opinion (*¿Qué tal si...?*)

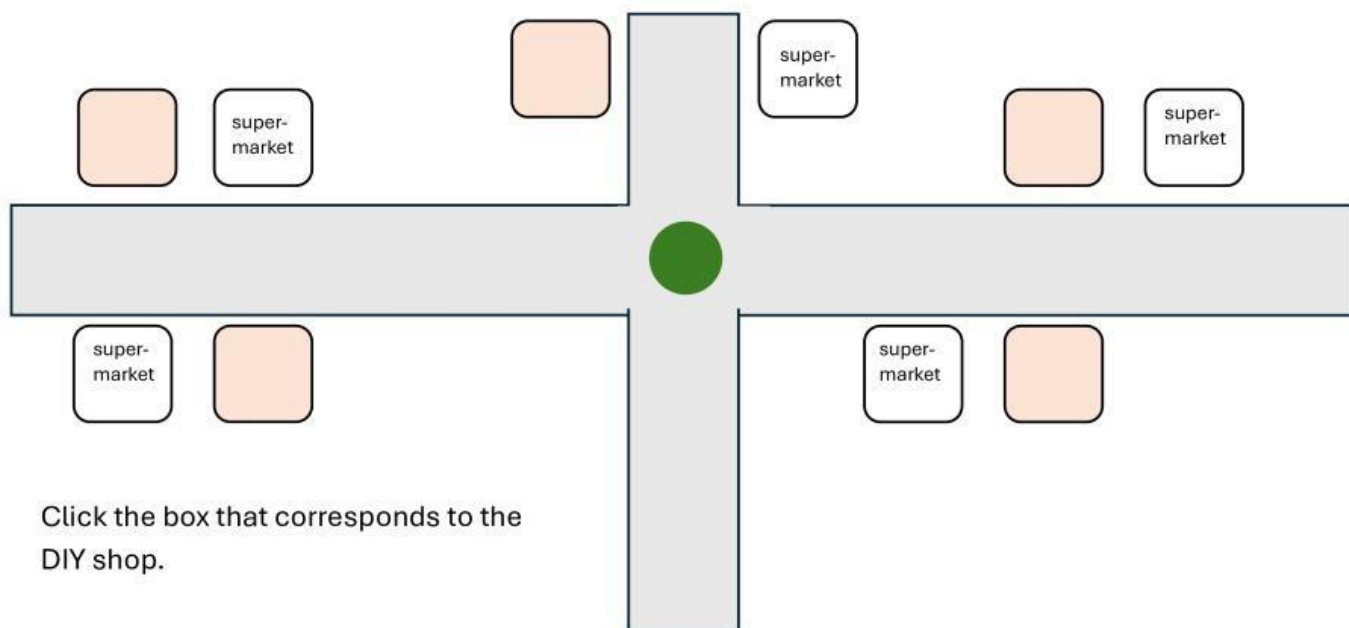
