Match the cause of poverty in Column A with its description in Column B by drawing lines to connect them.

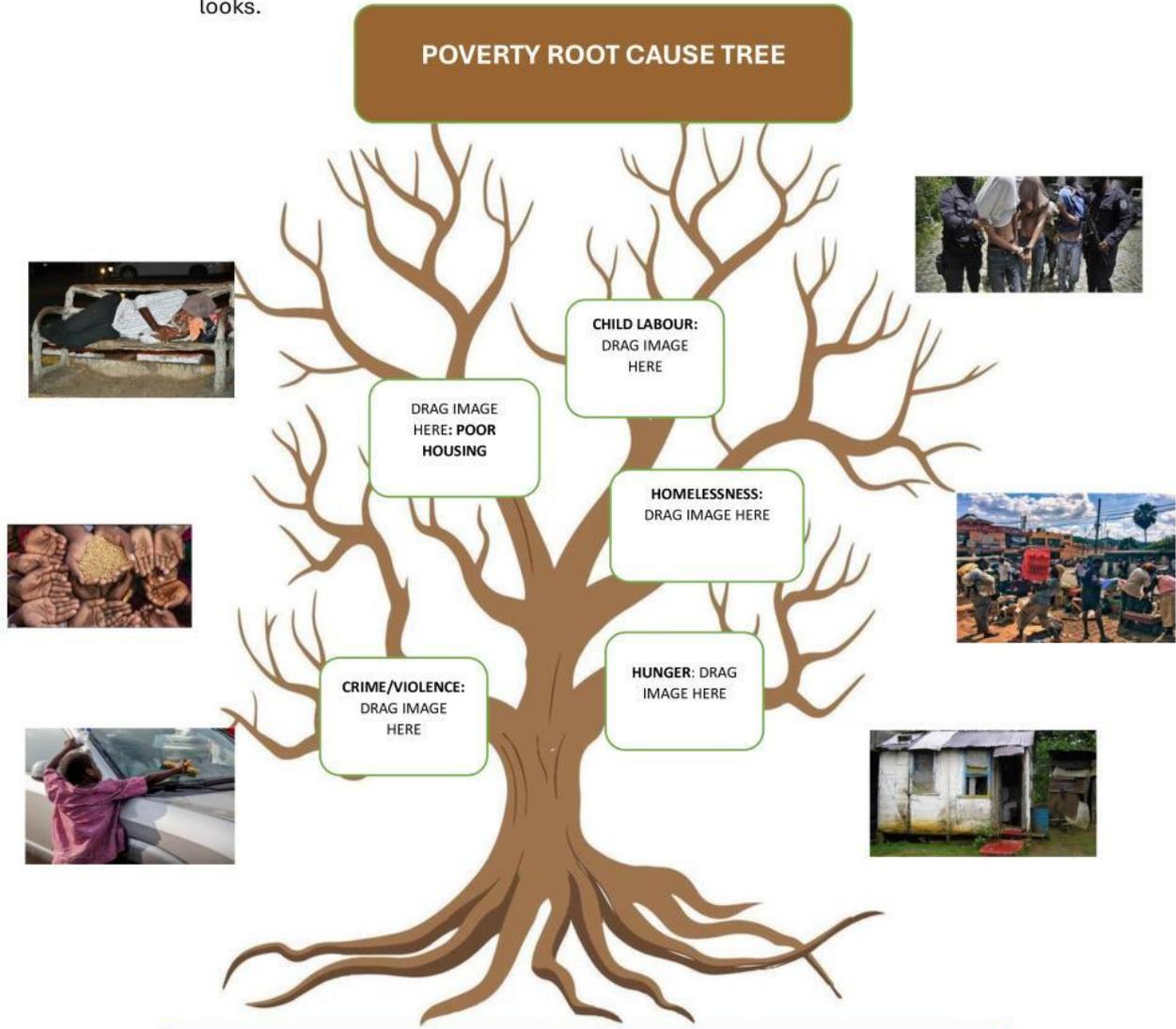
Column A: Causes of Poverty	Column B: Description of Causes
1. Address Bias <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Absent or insufficient water, food, shelter or other utilities necessary to live a dignified life.
2. Brain Drain	<input type="checkbox"/> Being granted or denied opportunities based on where you live or are from.
3. Chronic illness/ disability <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Dishonest or fraudulent practices that discourage investment and deprive the poor of assistance.
4. Corruption <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Earning less money than what is needed to cover basic needs.
5. Discrimination <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Events that threaten or cause damage to life and property.
6. Inflation <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Persistent or lifelong conditions which hampers individuals' abilities to work or earn an income.
7. Insufficient income <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Scarce/ very few paid employment opportunities for people who are able and willing to work.
8. Lack of access to basic amenities <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> The emigration of highly skilled and educated citizens resulting in insufficient human capital to develop the country.
9. Lack of jobs <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> Unjust treatment of people based on gender, ethnicity, beliefs or social status
10. Natural hazards/disasters <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/> When prices of goods and services increase but the value of money to purchase them decreases.

Activity 2:
