MythBusters is a science entertainment TV programme. Its aim is to prove that certain opinions are 1 **rational**, as well as to show how people often accept things that are untrue or 2 **interpret** the information they are given. The 'mythbusting' team finds out if various opinions are true or not through experiments. Most of them are conducted in a workshop. However, it's often 3 **practical** for them to work inside because of the space needed so some experiments are conducted outdoors. The myths are either 'confirmed' or 'busted', and when busted, the truth will often leave you 4 **speech**. Sometimes, however, neither of the two can be done. The team's 5 **inability** to work out what is really going on is only due to the fact that there is 6 **adequate** evidence. These myths are named 'plausible'. Many of the experiments are very dangerous and the team is quick to 7 **courage** viewers from copying them. There are some 8 **forgettable** episodes, like when the team was trying to build a rocket car. *MythBusters* is more than just a bit of fun and points out how we are often 9 **misinformed** about different facts and must use science to find out the truth.
