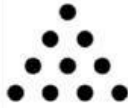

The table shows the first four triangular numbers.

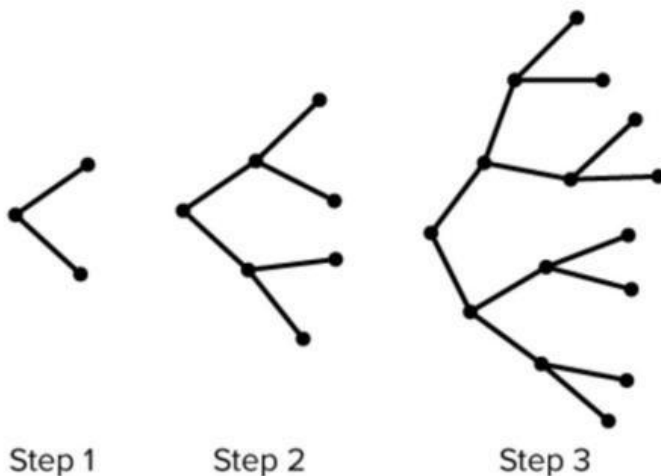
