Farwell.....Ahmad Zewail

Ahmad Zewail, an Egyptian scientist who was born on February 26, 1946. From Alexandria University, Ahmad Zewail received a Bachelor and Master of Science degrees in Chemistry. Ahmad Zewail was known as the "father of femtochemistry"; for his basic work in femtochemistry as he was a pioneer in this field. In 1999 he won Nobel Prize in Chemistry. In the same year, he received Egypt's highest state honor, the Grand Collar of the Nile. He was the author of sixteen books including his famous one "the era of science". Ahmad Zewail said "With science Egypt can make the modern history....I only want to serve Egypt in science and die as a scientist". Ahmad Zewail died at the age of seventy and buried in Egypt.
