

## การเรียงลำดับคำคุณศัพท์ (Adjective Order)

### สูตรการเรียงลำดับ (The Standard Order)

จำง่าย ๆ ด้วยอักษรย่อว่า **OSASCOMP** :

**O** - **Opinion** (ความเห็น): beautiful, ugly, smart, expensive

**S** - **Size** (ขนาด): big, tiny, tall, short

**A** - **Age** (อายุ/ความเก่า): new, young, old, ancient

**S** - **Shape** (รูปร่าง): round, square, flat, oval

**C** - **Color** (สี): red, blue, yellowish, dark

**O** - **Origin** (แหล่งกำเนิด/สัญชาติ): Thai, American, French, lunar

**M** - **Material** (วัสดุ): gold, wooden, cotton, plastic

**P** - **Purpose** (วัตถุประสงค์): sleeping (bag), running (shoes), frying (pan)

A beautiful big old round black Thai wooden table.

(ความเห็น > ขนาด > อายุ > ทรง > สี > สัญชาติ > วัสดุ > นาม)

Two expensive new Italian leather shoes.

(จำนวน > ความเห็น > อายุ > สัญชาติ > วัสดุ > นาม)
