

### Common mistakes with past tense verbs

When speaking about the past, don't use present tense verbs. Use past tense verbs.

Incorrect	Correct
Yesterday, I <b>work</b> all day.	Yesterday, I <u>worked</u> all day.

Don't add **ed** to irregular past tense verbs.

Incorrect	Correct
I <b>drinked</b> two cups of coffee yesterday.	I <u>drank</u> two cups of coffee yesterday.

Use **was** and **were** for the past tense of **to be**.

Incorrect	Correct
Laura <b>is</b> at work yesterday.	Laura <u>was</u> at work yesterday.

In negative past tense sentences, don't use a past tense verb. Use the base verb with **did not** or **didn't**.

Incorrect	Correct
We <b>didn't went</b> to Los Angeles.	We <u>didn't go</u> to Los Angeles.

Don't use **no** in negative past tense sentences.

Incorrect	Correct
I <b>no</b> buy soda.	I <u>didn't</u> buy soda.
