Grammar Rules Present-Tense Action Verbs

A **present-tense action verb** must agree with its subject.

Use **-s** at the end of an **action verb** if the subject is **he, she, or it**.

Examples:

*Carmella **loves** street fairs.*

*She **takes** me along with her.*

Do not add **-s** to the verb if the subject is **I, you, we, or they**.

Examples:

*Buyers **walk** slowly through the fair.*

*They **buy** a lot of things.*
