FIRST

If + Present ↔ Will
Modals
Imperative

When we talk about things that are possible in the future.

Shall we go to the beach?
If we go now, it won't be so crowded.
We can go if it doesn't rain

SECOND

If + Past Simple ↔
Simple Conditional

When we talk about the present and imagine something different from the real situation now or an unlikely situation in the future

I'm so tired.
If I weren't so tired, I would give you a hand.
I'd go for a walk if I could

THIRD

If + Past Perfect ↔
Perfect Conditional

When we talk about the past and imagine something different from the real situation then or an impossible situation in the past.

She got up late
If she had got up earlier, she would have arrived on time.
She would have had time for a shower if she had got up early
