A **pronoun** take the place of nouns (person, animal, place, thing, idea). Writers use pronouns to make their writing less repetitive.

1. **Subjective pronouns** are used **as the subject of a sentence**.
2. **Objective pronouns** are used **after action verbs**.
3. **Possessive pronouns** show **who or what owns, or possesses, something**.
4. **Reflexive pronouns** are used when **the person doing the action (subject) is the same as the person receiving the action (object)**.
