II. METHOD

1. UNDERLINE KEYWORDS

BƯỚC 1: Đọc câu hỏi và các đáp án trước khi nghe.

BƯỚC 2: Gạch chân những từ mang nghĩa quan trọng trong câu hỏi — thường là danh từ, động từ, tính từ chính, từ để hỏi. Bỏ qua các từ phụ như "the", "a", "is".

BƯỚC 3: Gạch chân từ khóa trong từng đáp án A, B, C, D để biết mình cần nghe cho thông tin gì.

BƯỚC 4: Khi nghe, tập trung vào các từ khóa đã gạch chân. Bài nghe thường không dùng y hệt từ trong đáp án mà sẽ paraphrase, nên cần nhận ra ý nghĩa tương đương.

2. ANSWER ELIMINATIONS

BƯỚC 1: Đọc cả 4 đáp án trước khi nghe và dự đoán loại thông tin cần tìm.

BƯỚC 2: Trong lúc nghe, loại ngay những đáp án mà bài nghe đã phủ nhận hoặc không đề cập.

BƯỚC 3: Nếu còn phân vân giữa 2 đáp án, nghe xem đáp án nào khớp với toàn bộ ý của đoạn, không chỉ một từ riêng lẻ. Bài nghe thường có bẫy bằng cách nhắc đến từ trong đáp án sai trước, rồi mới đưa ra thông tin đúng sau.

BƯỚC 4: Khoanh đáp án còn lại sau khi đã loại hết những đáp án sai.
