

RULE 1: ONE SYLLABLE WORDS

ADJECTIVE
tall ⇒ fast, hot

COMPARATIVE
taller ⇒ faster ⇒ hotter
Add '-ER' / compare 2 things

SUPERLATIVE
tallest ⇒ fastest ⇒ hottest
Add 'THE ...-EST' / compare 3+ things

SPELLING NOTES!
Big ⇒ Bigger | Biggest | C-V-C rule

RULE 2: TWO+ SYLLABLE WORDS

ADJECTIVE
happy ⇒ careful | beautiful

COMPARATIVE
happier, more careful, more beautiful
Y becomes I + '-ER' | 'MORE + word'

SUPERLATIVE
happiest, most careful, most beautiful
Y becomes I + 'THE ...-EST' | 'THE MOST + word'

Y ENDING RULE!
1 ⇒ Happier | 3+ ⇒ Happiest

RULE 3: THE REBELS (IRREGULARS)

ADJECTIVE
Good | Bad | Far

COMPARATIVE
Better | Worse | Farther/Further

SUPERLATIVE
The Best | The Worst | The Farthest/Furthest
