**give a hand, lend a hand**:to help (someone) do something



**have one's head in the clouds**: to be unaware or unrealistic about something

**to be head over heels** : to be deeply in love

**to keep an eye on sth/sb**: take care of, watch in order to protect

**keep one's chin up**: try to be cheerful , optimistic

**learn by heart**,: know by heart memorize

**(my) lips are sealed**: promise to keep a secret

**over my dead body**: not unless I'm dead and can't stop you

**pull one's leg**: joke or tease someone

**see eye to eye**: agree with somebody about something

**to have a sweet tooth**: to love of sugar or sweet things

**Let one's hair down**: relax, have fun down

**play something by ear** :do something without a plan or preparation
