The White Hat	Facts
How did you start your lesson? What strategy did you use? recall the steps What were your learning outcomes? How did you close your lesson?	
The Red Hat	feelings and emotions

The Black Hat	difficulties, caution and weaknesses
What difficulties did you face? What didn't you like about your lesson? What was missing in your lesson? What would you like to avoid in the next lesson?	
The Yellow Hat	benefits and strength
What situation did you feel happy about? What are the most highlights of your lesson? What made you satisfied or proud in your lesson?	
The Green Hat	alternatives and solutions
What are your suggestions to improve your performance? How could you achieve more effectively? How can you make your students more active? How can the SET or Supervisor support you?	
The Blue Hat	action plan, Process
Are your alternatives and action plan realistic? When can you apply your alternatives? When can you put a plan to start implementation?
