ACTIVE	Mountains	surround	the village
PASSIVE	The village	is surrounded	by mountains

- Form the present simple passive with the present simple form of the verb to be (am, is, are) and the past participle of the main verb
- ✓ The object of the active sentences becomes the subject of the passive sentences
- ✓ Use by + person or thing after the passive to include the object
