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Blog: The world in 80 flavours

Sri Lanka

1 ____

Sri Lanka is an island near the south east coast of India. Its widest part is 224 km and its longest part is 432 km. Around 22 million people live there. Sri Lanka's national dish is curry and rice, but there are many different types of rice and many different types of curry around the island. In fact, you can eat curry and rice in a different place every day for a week in Sri Lanka and never taste exactly the same thing.

2 ____

Most curries include meat (e.g. chicken) or seafood (e.g. fish) and vegetables (e.g. okra). They also include coconut milk and spices (e.g. turmeric). The rice can be white, yellow or red. You can buy curry and rice from many different types of places – cafés at the side of the road or very expensive restaurants. In some cafés and restaurants, you all share lots of dishes and in other places, you have your own meal.

3 ____

Curry is both a Sri Lankan and an Indian dish. Sri Lankan curry is similar to Kerala curry in the south east of India, but it's not exactly the same. Sri Lankan curry has more spices like turmeric in it, and so it's hotter. Sri Lankan chefs don't always put these spices in curries for tourists, because tourists don't always like very hot curries.

4 ____

Curry isn't the only food that people eat in Sri Lanka. They also eat vegetables like carrots and potatoes. They eat a flat bread called *roti* and different fruit like watermelon. *Watalappan* is very popular. It's a sort of dessert. It's made with brown sugar, coconut milk and egg.

5 ____

Sri Lankan food has a lot of local ingredients in it, but it also has food from other countries, too. That's because in the past, a lot of ships stopped in Sri Lanka with food from other places. Sri Lankan food has strong flavours. These are flavours that everyone needs to try.
