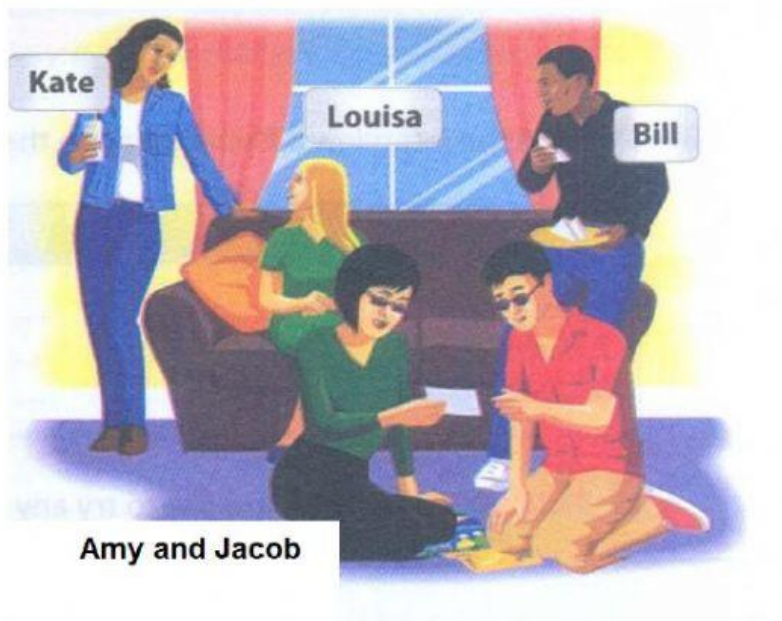

Important Reminder

/d/

If the -ed ending is preceded by a voiced sound, the ed ending is pronounced as /d/.

/t/

If the -ed ending is preceded by a voiceless sound, the -ed ending is pronounced as /t/.

/id/

If the -ed ending is preceded by a /t/ or /d/, the -ed ending is pronounced as /id/.
