II. METHOD: Skimming & scanning

- Đọc lướt (Skimming):

- + Đọc tiêu đề, câu đầu và câu cuối của mỗi đoạn.
- + Chú ý các từ khóa chính (danh từ, động từ, tính từ, trạng từ, từ để hỏi).
- + Xác định ý chính của đoạn/bài đọc.

- Đọc quét nhanh (Scanning):

- + Gạch chân từ khóa trong câu hỏi (ai, cái gì, ở đâu, khi nào...).
- + Lướt nhanh bài đọc, tìm từ/cụm từ trùng hoặc gần giống từ khóa.
- + Đọc kỹ câu chứa từ khóa, đối chiếu với câu hỏi để chọn đáp án.

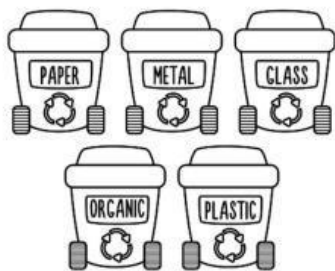

Helping the Earth Projects



Recycling Challenge: Start a classroom recycling challenge! Gather paper, plastic, and aluminum cans for a month. Create posters explaining which items can be recycled and why it helps the Earth. Assign teams to check bins and track progress. At the end of the challenge, discuss how recycling reduces pollution and saves resources. You can also make

creative crafts using recycled materials. Finally, present what you've learned to other students and encourage them to recycle too!

Plant a Garden: Create a small garden at school or home! Plant flowers, vegetables, or trees to help clean the air and provide food for people and animals. Research which plants grow best in your area and how they help the environment. Keep a journal to track plant growth, watering, and weather. Learn about composting to reduce food waste and help plants grow. Share your gardening experience with classmates and explain why plants are important for a healthy planet.



Clean-Up Day: Organize a community clean-up! Choose a park, beach, or schoolyard to clean. Work in teams to collect litter and separate recyclables from trash into two different groups. Keep a record of how much waste is collected. Discuss how litter harms animals and nature. After the cleanup, make signs to remind people not to litter.
