3. **Senate of Canada:** The Senate is the appointed upper chamber of Parliament that reviews and suggests changes to laws.
4. **Monarch:** The Monarch is Canada's ceremonial head of state, represented in the country by the Governor General.
5. **Gatineau:** Gatineau is a city in Quebec located just across the river from Ottawa.
6. **Ottawa:** Ottawa is the capital city of Canada where the federal government is based.
7. **Rideau Canal:** The Rideau Canal is a historic waterway in Ottawa that becomes the world's largest skating rink in winter.
8. **Prime Minister of Canada:** The Prime Minister is the leader of the federal government and the person responsible for running the country.
