Within this extended family, the oldest family member typically holds the greatest authority and takes charge of key domestic decisions. Each family follows its own rules and values: younger members are expected to show respect, while elders are encouraged to act with patience and kindness toward the younger generation. These traditional values still shape relations not only between families but also between husbands and wives.

Shared meals remain a powerful symbol of togetherness. Traditionally, the whole extended family would eat on the floor, though many households now use dining tables while keeping the same sense of intimacy. Influenced by Confucian ideals, Vietnamese mothers play a central role, often associated with love, sacrifice, and kindness. Children are widely regarded as the family's greatest treasure, and parents typically apply clear, sometimes strict rules to develop good behavior and responsibility. Although modern economic pressures have led many families - especially in cities - to have fewer children than in the past, the proverb "**Blood is thicker than water**" still resonates. It means that family relationships are the most important. Family ties are very strong in Vietnam.

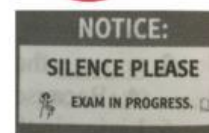
