

WORKSHEET: THE "TECH DETECTIVE" THEORY

STUDENTS' NAMES:

THE CASE OF THE MISSING BACKPACK



Someone left a backpack in the computer lab. Inside, the detectives found several technological clues. We need to identify the owners.



Activity 1: The police report is written in "Old English" (using of). Rewrite it into "Detective English" (using the 's) to make it clear for the judge.

Example: Clue A: The charger of Lucas. → It is Lucas's charger.

- Clue B: The smartwatch of the teacher. →
- Clue C: The earphones of Martina. →
- Clue D: The memory card of the principal →

Activity 2: The detective is interviewing suspects. Choose the correct question to find the owner.

Detective: "I found a smartphone."



- Question: (Who / What / Whose) smartphone is this?



Suspect: "It is Mateo's smartphone."

Detective: "I found a strange object in the lab."

- Question: (Who / What / Whose) is this?



Suspect: "It is a memory card for the camera."

Detective: "I found a webcam."

- Question: (Who / What / Whose) webcam is this?



Suspect: "It is the school's webcam."

Activity 3: Sometimes the police make mistakes in their reports. Find and highlight the error.

Write the correct form.

Example: Report: "That is the printers cable." (That is the printer's cable)

1. Report: "Who's microphone is this?"
2. Report: "It is the mouse pad of Julian."
3. Report: "Whose is that? It is a projector"
4. Report: " The charger of the tablet is missing."
