

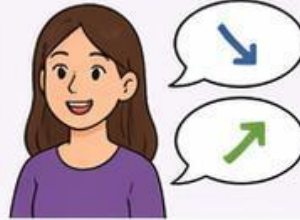
# ENGLISH PRONUNCIATION PRACTICE – B1
