FUTURE SIMPLE



The Future Simple is used to talk about actions that will happen in the future. We use it for predictions, decisions made at the moment, promises, and future facts.

Structures:

1. Affirmative: Subject + will + base verb + complement.
2. Negative: Subject + will not (won't) + base verb + complement.
3. Question: Will + subject + base verb + complement?
