In summer, lots of people spend their holidays at the beach, either in their home country or in another country. At the beach, you can always find children, teenagers and adults in the sea, either swimming, playing games or just talking. But did you know you can also do different sports in the water?

Surfing

Surfing is a popular sport for people of all ages because all you need is a wetsuit, a board and some big waves. In the past, the boards were made of wood which made them very heavy to carry and surf on, but now they are made of a lighter material so surfers can move faster. Some of the best places to surf are Portugal, France and the United States because of the big waves in the ocean, but if you aren't near a beach, you can also go to special surf pools to practise.



Kayaking

Kayaking is done in a long, pointed boat and you move the boat using long oars. Water Sports

Snorkelling

It involves swimming underwater with one of these masks on and a wetsuit if it's cold, and it's great fun because you have the chance to see lots of different fish, plants and other small marine animals. Sailing
