#### The Good and Bad Sides of AI

The world is changing quickly since the creation of Artificial Intelligence (AI). AI is when a computer program is able to do things that humans normally do, like learning and thinking. So AI could be defined as the new technology that acts like human **reasoning**. Some people find AI very helpful in their daily lives, but there are also some aspects of AI that can be **harmful** and worrying. Let's look at the good and bad sides of AI.

#### The Pros of AI

##### Avoid Mistakes

It is natural for humans to make mistakes. Artificial Intelligence uses precise and **accurate** information, which reduces the possibility of errors when we give it clear and correct instructions.

##### No Breaks

People usually work between four and eight hours a day and need breaks. We get tired and need to rest, but AI can work all day long without getting tired or bored, and without taking breaks.

##### Small Tasks

In our daily lives, there are small tasks that need to be done, like revising and correcting our written texts, sending emails or rescheduling meetings. With AI, we don't need to worry about these small tasks any more, they are done automatically for us.

##### Useful Apps

We have many applications in our daily routines that use AI to make our lives easier. We use apps for navigating, searching for the next bus, food delivery, health tracking, or virtual assistants for customers on websites.

## The Cons of AI

### Laziness

With so many applications **automating** our jobs, people can become lazy. We get comfortable and let machines do our work. We even give AI the responsibility of making decisions for us and choosing what to watch or buy.

### Risk of Losing Jobs

One of the biggest concerns about AI is that it could take away many jobs. If machines are so smart and can think and learn efficiently, why wouldn't they do the jobs people do now? They say that many jobs will be created too, but this issue still makes workers feel **uncertain** and worried.

### Lack of Bonds

Yes, machines can be more efficient than humans, but aren't personal relationships and good communication important in almost every job? AI won't be able to replace human bonds.

### Limited Creativity

AI is programmed to do tasks based on the information it is given. While it can create interesting things, it cannot have unique ideas or **think outside the box** like humans can.

As we can see, it is clear that we can benefit from what AI offers, but the human touch in creativity and thinking is irreplaceable. AI is a useful tool that can help us in our daily lives, but we should remember that the human ability to connect, communicate and create is unique.
