 4. Arrive a few minutes early. Arriving late for an interview is never a good thing.
 5. It's polite to give each of them a printed copy of your résumé. Bring several copies of your résumé with you.
 6. Smile, be friendly and confident. Use good eye contact and body language. Remember to relax, because, if you feel nervous, you will look and sound nervous.
 7. Finally, email your interviewers (after a day or two) and thank them for their time.
