Key Words

- **taxi rank:** a designated, often city-regulated area where taxis queue/line up or park, awaiting passengers :: [parada de taxis](#)
- **fare:** the money paid for a journey on public or private transport :: [tarifa](#)
- **meter:** a device installed in a taxi that automatically calculates the fare for a trip based on distance traveled, time elapsed, and fixed rates :: [taxímetro](#)
- **boot:** the rear compartment or trunk used to store luggage, shopping, or personal belongings :: [baúl](#)
- **back seat:** the rear seating area in a vehicle :: [asiento trasero](#)
- **passenger seat:** the front seat in a vehicle located directly next to the driver's seat, designed for a passenger rather than the operator :: [asiento del acompañante](#)
- **sat-nav system:** an electronic device or software that uses satellite signals—such as GPS—to calculate precise geographic coordinates :: [sistema de navegación por satélite](#)
- **to spare:** extra or leftover :: [extra](#), [en reserva](#)
- **keep the change:** a phrase used in transactions telling the recipient (such as a waiter, taxi driver, or cashier) to retain the remaining money owed back to the payer :: [quédate con el cambio](#)
- **route:** a designated path, course, or way taken for travel between places, often representing the fastest, safest, or most direct line :: [ruta](#)
- **left** :: [izquierda](#)
- **right** :: [derecha](#)
- **straight on** :: [derecho](#)
- **opposite:** someone or something located directly across, facing, or completely different in nature, character, or effect from another :: [opuesta](#), [enfrente](#)
- **near:** describes a short distance or time, indicating close proximity, immediacy, or similarity :: [cerca](#)
- **corner:** a point or area where two or more edges, surfaces, or lines converge, such as the angle of a room ([rincon](#)), a street intersection, or the edge of a table :: [esquina](#)
- **inside:** space within something (a container, building, or organization) :: [dentro](#)
- **outside:** the space beyond a boundary, building, or interior :: [fuera](#)
- **entrance:** a door, gate, passage, or way into a building, room, or space :: [entrada](#), [acceso](#)
- **fountain:** a structure that jets water into the air for decoration or to provide drinking water :: [fuente](#)
- **drop off:** to take someone or something to a destination :: [dejar](#)
