- **Funny:** divertido/a
- **Exciting:** emocionante
- **Interesting:** interesante
- **Popular:** popular
- **Boring:** aburrido/a
- **Scary:** de miedo
- **Sad:** triste
- **Disappointing:** decepcionante
- **Long:** largo/a

Part 2: Grammar - Quick Rules!

Recuerda las reglas para formar comparativos y superlativos:

Tipo de Adjetivo / Regla	Adjetivo (Ejemplo)	Comparativo (+ que)	Superlativo (el/la +)	Ejemplo de la Frase (del video)
1. Adjetivos Cortos (1 sílaba)	fast (rápido)	faster than (más rápido que)	the fastest (el más rápido)	A dog is faster than an elephant. The horse is the fastest.
2. Cortos terminados en -e	nice (agradable)	nicer than (más agradable que)	the nicest (el más agradable)	Harry is nicer than Frank. Dean is the nicest.
3. Cortos CVC (Consonante-Vocal-Consonante)	hot (caliente)	hotter than (más caliente que)	the hottest (el más caliente)	Monday was hotter than Sunday. Tuesday was the hottest day.
4. Adjetivos terminados en -y	happy (feliz)	happier than (más feliz que)	the happiest (el más feliz)	Mary is happier than Susan. Mike is the happiest.
5. Adjetivos Largos (2 o más sílabas)	expensive (caro)	more expensive than (más caro que)	the most expensive (el más caro)	A car is more expensive than a bike. The plane is the most expensive.
6. Adjetivos Irregulares	good (bueno) bad (malo)	better than (mejor que) worse than (peor que)	the best (el mejor) the worst (el peor)	You are a better singer than John. It was the worst decision.

Puntos Clave a Recordar:

- Usa **THAN** después de un adjetivo comparativo: faster THAN, more expensive THAN.
- Usa **THE** antes de un adjetivo superlativo: THE fastest, THE MOST expensive.
- **No mezcles las reglas:** Nunca digas "more fast" o "the beautifulest".
